Catarina Monteiro has a degree in History (2015) and a master's degree in Early Modern History and Discoveries (2019) from NOVA/FCSH, with the dissertation «When the shadows dim the light. Luísa and Ângela Sigeia: stories and life stories in Portugal in the 1500s». Currently, she is in the second year of the Interuniversity Doctoral Program in History (PIUDHist), with a PhD scholarship from CIDEHUS-UÉ/FCT, with the project «A 'Senhora D. Catarina': Women and political action in Europe (1550 -1650)», under the scientific supervision of Mafalda Soares da Cunha (CIDEHUS-UÉ) and Fernando Bouza Álvarez (U. Complutense de Madrid).

She is a member of the Organizing Committee of the VIII edition of the International Meeting of Young Investigators of Early Modern History (EJIHM), taking place in Évora, in June 2023. She is also part of the project «RESISTANCE – Rebellion and Resistance in the Iberian Empires, 16th-19th Centuries », funded by European funds (European Commission / Marie Skłodowska-Curie) and led by the University of Évora. She is also a member of the Asociación Española de Jóvenes Modernistas (U. Autónoma de Madrid) and the Royal Studies Network..

Her academic interests encompass gender history, women's history and studies on agency, memory and representations. In her doctoral project, she proposes to analyze and discuss the role of some women from royal and/or aristocratic houses in Europe between 1550 and 1650, contrasting their practices and agency with the memory that was built on them (in counterpoint with the masculine gender), using as a line of comparison the life trajectory of the Infanta Duchess D. Catarina (1540-1614).
