

Sónia C. M. Santos Rebocho was born in Rio Maior, district of Santarém, where she lives and works at the City Council, as a senior technician assigned to the Research and Archeology Service.

With a degree in Social Policy (ISCSP-UTL, 1997), a master's degree in Cultural and Political History (NOVA FCSH, 2007) and a postgraduate degree in Planning and Mediation in Multicultural Contexts (Portuguese Catholic University, 2010), she is currently pursuing a PhD in History, specialization in Contemporary History, being integrated into the HTC – History, Territories, Communities, NOVA FCSH hub of the Functional Ecology Center of the Faculty of Science and Technology of the University of Coimbra.

She published the book *Alves da Veiga (1849-1924): Uma Proposta de Organização Federativa da Sociedade Portuguesa* and several articles associated with the themes on which she has focused her academic research, namely the Portuguese republican movement (1848-1910) and more specifically, within this, the wing that defended the adoption of federalist solutions for the country, both at the level of internal organization and in the context of interstate relations.

As part of the work carried out at the Rio Maior City Council, she recently collaborated on the editorial initiatives *Memórias Paroquiais de 1758: Concelho de Rio Maior* (2020) and *Feira de Setembro: 300 Anos* (2022).
